Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I feel that it is important to pass on the following message from Bishop Joe:
 “In the past week, during a peaceful protest related to the recent shootings and deaths of Alton Sterling in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, and Philando Castile in Falcon Heights, Minnesota, 11 law enforcement officers were shot, five of whom were killed. Our hearts ache for the families of the young men who were killed in Louisiana and Minnesota, and our hearts also ache for the police officers who were wounded and the families of the police officers who were killed in Dallas. As Christians, we hold fast to our faith in Jesus Christ who broke down the dividing wall of hostility and division between us (Eph 2:14). Because we believe every life is sacred and every person is precious, we must continue to pray for the conversion of all people to safeguard the inherent dignity and value of every human life. We recognize the frustration and anger people feel—particularly those who are marginalized because of race or ethnicity—as well as the distress and anger stemming from assaults against law enforcement officers. We must work to unite and heal our communities. Let us join together and pray for the families of those who have suffered or have been affected by violence, hatred and oppression.”

Ethics and Integrity in Ministry


As we gear up for another school year, it is time to evaluate our need to take this course or update an expiring compliance. What exactly is EIM?

Definitions

1. "Ethical behavior" is behavior that is consistent with the morals and teachings of the Catholic Church. It is fundamental to the mission of the Diocese that Church personnel exhibit the highest ethical behavior.
2. "Integrity" is characterized by honesty, soundness of judgment and sincerity of manner. Church personnel are expected to maintain a high standard of integrity and an environment free from harassment.
3. "Scandal" is an attitude or behavior which leads another to do evil. Scandal damages virtue and integrity. It is a grave offense if, by deed or omission, another is deliberately led into a grave offense (Catechism of the Catholic Church, No. 2284).
