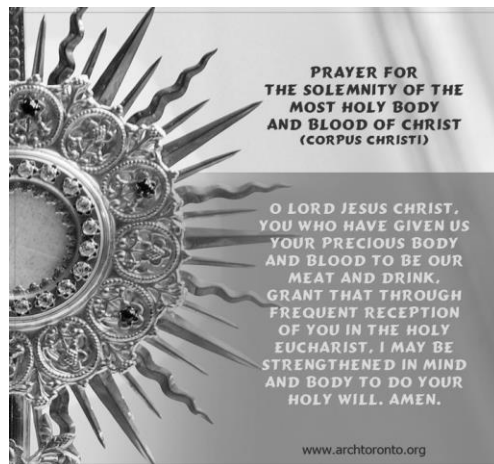
The Solemnity of the Holy Body and Blood of Christ (also known in Latin as Corpus Christi) is celebrated in most countries on Thursday after Trinity Sunday. In the US, we celebrate on the following Sunday. St. Thomas Aquinas is given credit for many of the customs and hymns associated with Corpus Christi.

The feast of Corpus Christi owes a rather large debt to St. Juliana, a nun of Liege, Belgium, who was led to start a celebration around AD 1230. At an early age, she developed a strong devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, and she longed for a feast in honor of the Eucharist. In AD1264 a bull of Pope Urban IV commanded universal observance of the feast. Although Urban's death impeded the spread of the feast, by the 14th century, the feast became universally celebrated in the West.

In some ways every Sunday is a feast of the Eucharist, because by participating in the Mass, and in receiving Communion, we are honoring and celebrating His Body and Blood. The Eucharist is one way Jesus has fulfilled his promise to be with us “to the end of the age” (Matthew 28:20). Revelations 19:9 gives us joy in knowing “Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.”

The Scripture today reminds us that “we, many though we are, are one body for we all partake of the one loaf.” How are we using our gifts of time and talent to build up the Body of Christ?

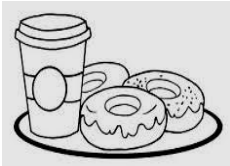

HOSPITALITY SUNDAY

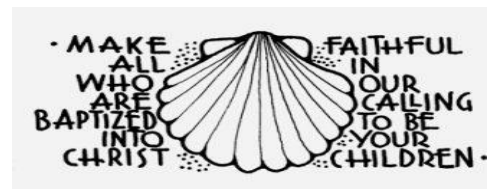
Altar Society will be hosting Father's Day hospitality after **ALL**
