



Blessed Virgin Mary, Mission, Welcomes Bishop Joe S. Vasquez

With joyful hearts, the Blessed Virgin Mary Catholic Mission, on the Old Washington on the Brazos, Texas, warmly welcomes his Excellency, Most Reverend Joe S. Vasquez, the Bishop of the Diocese of Austin to our Fifteenth anniversary of the dedication of our Church and one year rededication of our remodeled Church. Bishop, from the bottom of our hearts, we say, thank you, for finding time to grace this joyful event with Mass, despite your busy schedule. We are indeed grateful! We pray for you and your episcopal ministry in our Diocese of Austin.

Brief history of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mission

In 1848, the Spann family arrived in Washington County, Texas, from South Carolina, bringing with them slaves. The Spanns catechized the slaves and saw that they were baptized Catholic. Well educated, the Spanns hosted numerous priests and seminarians sent to them by Texas bishops. Hard times came after the Civil War, however, and the family apparently left the area. For many decades, the African American Catholics in the area found themselves without pastors and often without even priests. The Ku Klux Klan often tried to keep white priests from coming in to celebrate the sacraments with the community. The faith was handed down from parent to child through family traditions.

The Josephite fathers served the community during the 1940's and '50's. In 1969, under the pastorship of Father Robert Mahoney, the community constructed a one-story, multi-purpose building that is still in use today.

Soon after Msgr. Ralph Brennan was assigned pastorship of Blessed Virgin Mary in 1987, parishioners began discussing building a new church. With assistance from the Catholic Extension Society, a missionary association based in Chicago, and funds from Catholics throughout the Austin Diocese, the parishioners of Blessed Virgin Mary were able to raise a new edifice.

The newest church at that time in the Austin Diocese serves the oldest African American community in Texas. It stands as a proud symbol of their ancestors' toil, their determination to hold onto the land and to their faith, and a reminder of what it means to be delivered from the bondage of Egypt, to be strengthened by wanderings in the desert, and to finally find the sweet taste of freedom in Christ, Amen! God bless you.
