The Novena to the Holy Spirit is the oldest novena in the Church. Jesus himself asked for it. "Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, 'Which', He said, "you heard of from Me" (Acts 1:4). When Jesus had ascended to heaven, the disciples with the Virgin Mary returned to Jerusalem and waited praying together for the Father's promise - the Holy Spirit.

So this novena is made in all the Church from Ascension Thursday until the vigil of Pentecost (Saturday).

We all agree that the Holy Spirit inspired and gathered not just the Church, but also our Faith and Light communities, and continues to accompany us. Hearing all the time how new friends and families are lacking and how communities are aging, and finally, having read Ghislain's Easter letter ("Our breathing is starting to fail... Last year during our big international gathering in Leeds the conclusion was made that our communities are getting old, that some of them will even cease to exist, few new communities are established, it's hard to attract young people and families...") I thought it was time to turn in a special way to the One who is the Spirit of God, who inspires all that is alive, thanks to whom we are alive at all.

Therefore I propose to approach Pentecost this year with a special prayer by our community (the novena this year starts on May 30), each day praying "Come, Holy Spirit..." for Faith and Light in all the world.
