WINDTHORST IMMUNIZATION CLINIC –The Department of State Health Services will be conducting an Immunization Clinic in Windthorst, in the Meeting Room in the Parish Hall on **Thursday, January 5, 2017 from 1:00 – 3:00**. Vaccines are available for Kindergarten Seventh Grade, and College entry. All infant Immunizations will also be offered. Adult immunizations are available to those who qualify. The Texas Department of State Health Services provides vaccines for those on Medicaid, no insurance, American Indian, Native Alaskan, and the under-insured. CHIPS, Medicare, and private insurance are not accepted at this clinic. If your private insurance covers vaccines, you will be referred to your doctor. Parent or guardians must accompany a minor. VFC vaccines are provided for \$10.00 per visit, with a maximum of \$20.00 per household. Adult vaccines are \$20.00 per visit for the adult with no insurance.
