An usher will remain in the vestibule, at the front door, to allow late comers to come inside quietly and silently until the Gospel begins. The last two middle long pews will be roped off and an usher will escort late arrivals to one of these pews. If the center pews are full, ushers will then instead usher late comers to opening places in the rear short pews on the south side or if preferred to the cry room.

The current two pews reserved as "Parents with Children" are now moved forward by two pews, and signs will be repositioned.

Users will sit in the two small pews on the right side as you enter the Church. See "Usher" sign on the rear short pews.

PLENARY INDULGENCE: The remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sin whose guilt has already been forgiven. A properly disposed member of the Christian faithful can obtain an indulgence under prescribed conditions through the help of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints. An indulgence is partial if it removes part of the temporal punishment due to sin, or plenary if it removes all punishment.

May it unite me more closely to you, the One true God, and lead me safely through death to everlasting happiness with You. And I pray that You will lead me, a sinner, to the banquet where you with Your Son and holy Spirit, are true and perfect light, total fulfillment, everlasting joy, gladness without end, and perfect happiness to your saints. Grant this through Christ our Lord. Amen. (St. Thomas Aquinas)

PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS TO CONSECRATED LIFE

O God, throughout the ages you have called women and men to pursue lives of perfect charity through the evangelical counsels of poverty, chastity, and obedience. We give you thanks for these courageous witnesses of Faith and models of Inspiration. Their pursuit of holy lives teaches us to make a more perfect offering of ourselves to you. Continue to enrich your Church by calling forth sons and daughters who, having found the pearl of great price, treasure the Kingdom of Heaven above all things. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, One God forever and ever Amen.

PRECEPTS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

1 You shall attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor. We must "sanctify the day commemorating the resurrection of the Lord" (Sunday), as well as the principal feast days, known as Catholic holy days of obligation (catholic-holy-days-of-obligation). This requires attending Mass, "and by resting from those works and activities which could impede such a sanctification of these days."

2 You shall confess your sins at least once a year. We must prepare for the Eucharist by means of the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession). This sacrament "continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness."

3 You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season. This "guarantees as a minimum the reception of the lord's Body and Blood in connection with the Paschal feasts, the origin and center of the Christian liturgy."

4 You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church. "The fourth precept ensures the times of asceticism and penance which prepare us for the liturgical feasts and help us acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart."

5 You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church. "The fifth precept means that the faithful are obliged to assist with the material needs of the Church, each according to his own ability."

Note that these precepts of the Catholic Church are required, unless you have a legitimate reason for not meeting them. For example:

If you are sick, tending to a sick child, or camping in the wilderness on Sunday and cannot get to Mass, it is not a grave violation to miss Mass that day.

Children, the elderly, and pregnant or nursing women do not have to fast on normal fast days (Ash Wednesday and Good Friday).
