



RELIGIOUS FREEDOM WEEK

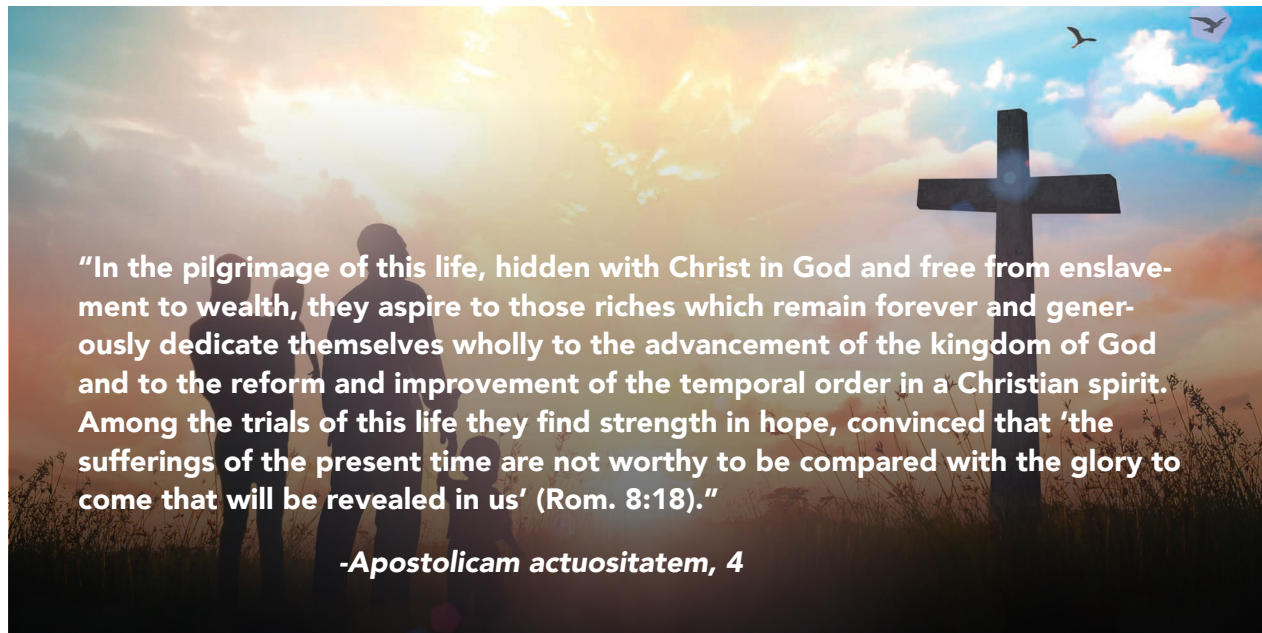
