Courses being developed for the fall semester thus far:

****The Consolation of Philosophy* by Boethius. This work, written in the sixth century while Boethius was awaiting execution, is an aid to all who struggle with faith in a world hostile to faith. It was not written for philosophers but for anyone who is seeking what the meaning of happiness is and is troubled by the reality of evil being tolerated by an all good God.

****Mary and the Fathers of the Church.* Written by Fr. Luigi Gambero, one of the world's most renowned scholars on the development of early Christianity, the book offers insights into the role of Mary as the Church understood it from as early as the first century.

****Bearing False Witness: Debunking Centuries of Anti-Catholic History.* Written by Rodney Stark, distinguished professor of the social sciences and co-director of the Institute for Studies of Religion at Baylor University, the book unmasks the "polite" anti-Catholic bigotries that are often presented as "truths." Particularly interesting is that Mr. Stark is not a Catholic. He states in his introduction: "*I did not write this book in defense of the Church. I wrote it in defense of history.*"

****Ignatius Press: The Gospel of John.* This will be held at Kaycee.

****Rite of Christian Initiation.* Using the Symbolon program from the Augustine Institute, readings from the New Catholic Answer Bible and the Catechism of the Catholic Church this course of study is designed primarily for non-Catholics or Catholics who have not made their

Confirmation or have been away from the Church for a long time and wish to look at the beliefs and teachings of the Church in more depth.

These courses will focus on discussing weekly assigned readings from the books. Sometime in August course outlines will be made available and people will be asked to register. Books will be ordered for those who signed up at a discounted rate.

The days that these classes will be held is still under consideration. All classes will be held at 7:00 p.m.

There is the possibility that additional courses will be offered.
