### **Registration for the Adult Formation**

### **CCD Registration is being held.**

We ask that parents please register their children before CCD starts on Wednesday, September 13<sup>th</sup> -- 3:45pm for grades Pre-K thru 4<sup>th</sup>; 7pm

for grades 5-8th. We would like to have an idea of how many children we need to prepare for and it avoids the last-minute rush to get the paper work done.

Shuttle bus service from Meadowlark School will continue to be offered for those parents who work and cannot get their kids to CCD. If you need to take advantage of this program, please call Carol Gagliano the CCD coordinator or the parish office as soon as possible.

**Issues for the congregation to vote on the weekend of September 23 and 24:** Ballots will be available for registered parishioners. If you have not registered, please do so as soon as possible. Registration forms can be found at the front entrance of the Church. You will be asked to sign the ballot.

1. The Sunday Mass schedule:
  - a. Permanently drop the Sunday 10:00 a.m. Mass and move the 8:00 a.m. Mass to 9:00 a.m. keeping the Saturday evening Mass as is. We will have only one Mass on Sunday morning.
  - b. Temporarily drop the Sunday 10:00 a.m. Mass and move the 8:00 a.m. Mass to 9:00 a.m. only for the months of September to May and restore the two Sunday morning Masses at 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. during the months of June, July and August. Keep the Saturday evening Mass as is.
  - c. Leave the Sunday Mass schedule as it is.
2. The weekend bulletin
  - a. Stop printing the Sunday bulletin and have copies for those do not have a computer or smartphone to access the bulletin on line.

- b. Keep printing the Sunday bulletin.

**Is Purgatory real? Where is Purgatory in Scripture? What is it? Where is it? What is our relationship with those we call “dead”? Do the obligations of love and charity stop with death? Do they care about us?** The idea of a necessary purification of souls that depart this life was prevalent in ancient Judaism and among some Jewish believers today. The goal of this life is to depart in complete harmony with God. But should that not be the case, the mercy of God will strip away whatever would block the soul from full union with Him. What we all want but can never have is cheap grace. God loves us too much for that. Purification after death is a great mercy from God.

We will use the book The Biblical Basis for Purgatory by John Salza for our discussions. There will be four meeting dates. Since I have most evenings being used for book discussions I will do this series on Monday evenings in October at 7:00 p.m., ending in time for the Feast of All Souls, November 2.

Sign up will take place starting this weekend to the first weekend of September.

Even if you cannot make the classes, this is an excellent book to have for your own reading and reflection.

**Needed: CCD teachers.** We are very fortunate to have had good CCD teachers. There is, however, always a need for more help. Need grades 4 & 5 teachers! The ideal is to have two in each classroom. If you would like to volunteer to help teach the Faith, please contact Carol Gagliano, 684-5751. You will probably need to have a background check done, which the parish will pay for but it takes time to complete. No one...without exception...is permitted to work with children until they have successfully passed a background check.
