From Fr. Pete. I have my pre-op physical on October 1. Hopefully all will go well, and my left knee will be replaced on Monday, October 8. Another round of physical therapy will begin immediately after surgery. I will not be allowed to say the weekend or daily Mass for a few weeks or until the surgeon gives me the OK. Moving, walking, etc. are permitted and encouraged but standing in one position for any length of time is not. Fr. Carl Beavers will be here to cover the weekend Masses only and any funerals. I should be able to make Communion calls in a week or two.

I would ask that people not bring any food to the rectory. Your generosity was incredible after the last surgery but there was so much food.

Please keep Fr. Bob Fox and Fr. Kevin Koch in your prayers. Both of these good priests have been diagnosed with cancer and have begun their treatments.

Welcome Victor Hannuneh! Victor and his son have come from Bethlehem to display and sell the hand carved olive wood products made by artists in the area. Come over after the Masses and see the craftsmanship. They make excellent gifts, especially with Christmas quickly coming upon us.

Does what we do in the everyday grind of family life and work really matter? Yes....at least for the believer. Consider the following meditation from Servant of God Madelein Delbrel, a French laywoman, writer and mystic who devoted her life to caring for the poor and evangelizing the secular culture of her time. She entered eternity in 1964.

The obligation to announce the Good News makes us walk at God's pace and at the same time at our own, which often gives us the gait of someone who is crippled or half-blind.

With all our powers, our spirit, and our heart we make our evangelization consist of applying the program drawn up by Jesus Christ. But, though we know the program, we have at best a very dim understanding of the plan.

Even if the work of each day has been perfectly achieved we don't know what use the Lord is going to make of it...and if it is extremely clumsy and poorly done we know even less how it will be used.

All we know is that anything surrendered to God is never lost.

The meals and events were enjoyed by all who attended. Everything went smoothly due to months of careful planning. It was good to see the Church full for the talks.
