Fr. Ray is the pastor of St. Rose of Lima in

Torrington. On October 15 he was life-flighted

to Cheyenne where he underwent a procedure

to remove a blockage from one of his coronary

arteries. The procedure was successful and

he is expected to make a full recovery.

Some comments made about heating in

the church during our recent run with

winter weather: "That church is cold enough

to hang meat in." "Maybe Father's knees

wouldn't hurt so much if he turned up the

heat." "You could get frost bite at Mass."

Post-surgical update. This surgery was a bit

more brutal than the last one and the recovery

is taking longer than I had hoped. There was a

lot more sawing of bones this time around.

Unfortunately, the operating theatre did not

have a camera so I was unable to watch this

procedure but I chose to stay awake and the

surgeon explained what he was doing. The

anesthesiologist was able to position me to

watch how she used a sonogram to guide a

needle into the knee to administer a block,

pointing out nerves and blood vessels. That

was fascinating.

The morning after the last surgery I was

walking up and down stairs. Not this time! It

took a lot of effort just to get my legs to the

edge of the bed, but I was determined to get up

and walk and I did. The surgeon warned me

ahead of time that no two surgeries are the same. I was discharged on Wednesday and started physical therapy on Thursday. The leg does not like all the new hardware and swells up. Standing in one position for any length of time is very uncomfortable. Once again, I have to re-learn how to walk, and it seems to be going slower this time around.

I meet with my surgeon this Monday to have the stitches removed and hopefully get some sense of when I can expect to resume a normal work routine.

As with the last surgery there is amazingly very little pain. I have not needed pain medication either at the hospital or at home. This in turn allows me to drive.

The good news: the knees are done. Some 20 years of arthritic pain and its intrusion in my life are over. By this time next year, I should be able to hunt, snowshoe, cross country ski and go horseback riding.

The bad news: I am amazed how quickly I get tired. My energy level is not where it normally is. I am told this is to be expected and will improve with time. So...you just suck it up and get on with the program.
