



STATEMENT FOR SACRAMENTAL POLICY

As a Catholic community our faith is nurtured by God's Word, tradition, and the sacraments – all of which flow from the Church as a living community of faith. Sacraments are encounters with the living Christ in and through his Body, the Church.

We deprive ourselves and our children of the fullness of God's life when we separate the sacraments from the lived experience of Christian life in the community. The Church is more essential to us than ritual, for ritual is meaningless without full participation in the Church.

We want our young people to receive the sacraments in relationship with the primary people in their lives, namely, their parents. In Baptism, parents have promised to participate in the faith life of their children and we want to help them in any way we can to fulfill that commitment.

To assist parents in understanding what is required for the reception of the Sacraments in St. Matthew's Parish, the following guidelines are provided.


