WHAT IS IT?

A day to forget about hectic *wedding* plans and concentrate on *marriage* plans.

An opportunity to be with married couples, reflect together as a couple and talk with other engaged couples about the sacrament of marriage.

WHY ATTEND?

To gain insights and better appreciation of self and intended partner.

To better understand what the *covenant* of sacramental marriage means.

This is *one* option of marriage preparation offered by the Diocese of Nashville; the couples must still meet with the Priest or Deacon in their parish.

WHAT TO EXPECT Before the Retreat.

Welcome Packet: a letter acknowledging the registration in a particular retreat, which is sent approximately one month prior to the retreat.

Also included are 2 Myers-Briggs Type Inventory Forms (to be filled out at home and brought to the retreat) and directions to the retreat.

Welcome Call: this call comes from a team member about 1 week before the retreat to welcome the couple to the retreat.

WHERE IS THE Retreat Located?

The retreat takes place at the Scarritt-Bennett Center, 1008 19th Avenue South Nashville, TN 37212.

HOW MUCH IS IT?

The cost is \$150 per couple. This includes all materials, continental breakfast, coffee breaks and lunch. Registrations are processed only upon receipt of the application and fee of \$150. Registration is available with secure credit card processing at:
