The daily Mass readings have intensified during this week as Jesus is coming closer to His final confrontation with the religious leaders of his day. In a few days, Jesus will be arrested, tortured, and killed all in the name of preserving the religious values of His time. But first, the crowds will welcome Him waving palms and singing "Hosanna!!!" in expression of their adoration, praise, and joy of Jesus entering Jerusalem. A few days later they will yell even louder "CRUCIFY HIM!!! CRUCIFY HIM!!!" As we go through the wonderful readings and liturgy of Holy Week, each of us will have the opportunity to reflect on what role we would play if we were present at the first Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter morning. During this week I ask you to reflect on what is your greatest spiritual need at this point in your life? Where do you see yourself in the readings of Holy Week? And, how will you let the suffering, death, and resurrection of Christ enter your heart and purify you so that you can be filled with His love and grace?
