Music at the Basilica

Music for the Solemnity of All Saints

The Communion motet this week is the popular "Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring." The melody of this piece was not written by Bach, but by Johann Schop (c. 1590-1667), a virtuoso violinist who wrote it as the hymn (in 4/4 time) *Werde munter, mein Gemüte*. It was used by Bach for the chorale movements (6 and 10) of his cantata *Herz und Mund und Tat und Leben*, BWV 147. It gained prominence in the 20th century in numerous transcriptions, and in Wendy Carlos' album *Switched-On Bach*, on the Moog synthesizer.



The postlude is based on the same chorale, and comes from the Neumeister Collection, a manuscript compilation of chorale preludes for organ assembled by Johann Gottfried Neumeister (1757–1840) after 1790. It has been suggested that the collection may have been copied from a single source, possibly a Bach family album put together in Johann Sebastian Bach's early years. Some time after 1807 the manuscript passed to Christian Heinrich Rinck (1770–1846), whose library was bought by Lowell Mason in 1852. After Mason's death in 1873, his collection was acquired by Yale University in New Haven, Connecticut. There the Neumeister volume lay until it was rediscovered "early in 1984" by musicologists Christoph Wolff (Harvard) and Hans-Joachim Schulze (de) (Bach-Archiv Leipzig) and librarian Harold E. Samuel (Yale). A win for Harvard, and musical culture generally! One wonders what other treasures have been lost over time.

RESTORATION UPDATE

ALL SUNDAY MASSES WILL BE CELEBRATED in the YOUTH CENTER AT 268 MULBERRY ST. (just south of Houston Street)

NOVEMBER 1st

The temporary partition that divided the nave is now completely removed. Progress is being made in laying down travertine stone. The pews have been refurbished and ready to be re-installed. The application of the "prime paint" is underway on the walls and ceiling.

Probably the most dramatic news is the installation of the large Rose Window on the east side of the church facing Mulberry Street. It is the oldest stained glass in the church having been originally installed in 1867. All the other stained glass windows will follow over the next three months.

The installation of the Memorial to Archbishop John Hughes in the courtyard will occur on 11-14.
