MUSIC AT THE BASILICA

Music for the Seventh Sunday of Easter

Many of J.S. Bach's keyboard works were used partly as compositional laboratory, and partly as instructional material; the six Trio Sonatas for Organ, BWV 525-530, were likely written for his keyboard-virtuoso son Wilhelm Friedemann. Normally, trio sonatas are played by three instruments; in these, there is nothing for the (single) organist to cling to: they are famously difficult. The first sonata is a wholly original work unlike some others.

At Offertory, we will hear an excerpt from the famous Gloria of Bach's contemporary, Antonio Vivaldi (1678-1741). You may recognize it from its use in film. The piece is a solo for contralto based on the words Qui sedes ad dexteram Patris (You sit at the right hand of the Father). Vivaldi was an Italian Baroque composer, Catholic priest, and virtuoso violinist. Born in Venice, Vivaldi was recognized as one of the greatest Baroque composers. His influence during his lifetime was widespread, which can be heard in the works (i.e., the trio sonatas) of J. S. Bach. Many of Vivaldi's compositions were written for the female music ensemble of the Ospedale della Pietà, a home for abandoned children where Vivaldi had been employed from 1703 to 1715 and from 1723 to 1740.

Regina caeli is the ancient Latin Marian antiphon, sung at the end of Compline (Night Prayer) during the Easter season. It is one of the four great Marian antiphons sung throughout the liturgical year; this setting is by Charles Gounod (1818-1893). After winning the Prix de Rome, Gounod spent four years in Italy studying sacred polyphony from the 16th century, especially the works of Palestrina. Gounod is famous for his Ave Maria, set to Bach's C major Prelude from the Well-Tempered Clavier. It was Fanny Mendelssohn, Felix's sister, who introduced him to the works of Bach, which he used as "his textbook." He wrote much music, including operas (Faust, Romeo and Juliet) and sacred music. His funeral took place at the Church of the Madeleine, with Camille Saint-Saëns playing the organ and Gabriel Fauré conducting.

Holy Doors of Mercy

The Basilica of St. Patrick's Old Cathedral is honored, with the blessing of Cardinal Dolan, to have HOLY DOORS at its sister church, the Shrine Church of the Most Precious Blood for the duration of the Holy Year.

With these Holy Doors open 24hrs a day, pilgrims passing through them will benefit from indulgences and blessings. Pilgrims will reflect on the major theme of the Holy Year – the universal reach of God's mercy – by viewing a display of presepio, crafted in this city of Naples by La Scarabattola.

For those in a state of grace and fulfilling the other prescribed conditions, a plenary indulgence may be gained once day by passing through the Holy Doors. A plenary indulgence removes all punishment due to sin.

Those seeking the indulgence are encouraged to begin a pilgrimage starting at the Basilica of St. Patrick's Old Cathedral where a Prayer of Mercy may be said. The pilgrim then may proceed down to the Shrine Church of the Most Precious Blood where the Holy Doors of Mercy are located.



Stained Glass Windows

With great joy, four refurbished windows will be installed this coming week in the sanctuary area, two windows on each side. Keep in mind, that the restoration of the windows is a monumental effort since that tracery sections of the windows (the woodwork that frames the stained glass) had to be hand hewn from hard wood. This had to be replaced because the old frames and tracery were so deteriorated that they no longer could safely hold the glass in place. The remaining stained glass windows will be completed over the spring and summer.

The stained glass that you now see is the same glass that was there before the restoration. The glass looks new because each piece was cleaned and in some cases replaced where there were breaks or pieces missing.

Weekday Masses

As a result of the work being done inside and outside the Basilica during the installation of the four stained glass windows, the church will be closed from Monday to Friday for the next two weeks. The weekday Masses - 8:00AM & 12:10PM - will be celebrated in St. Michael's Russian Catholic Church at 266 Mulberry Street.
