MUSIC AT THE BASILICA

Music for the 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time



On the fourth week of each month, we typically sing the Offertory antiphon (Offertorium) “proper” to the day. The Offertory antiphons are neglected, since they comprise some of the most difficult chant to sing, originally sung by a schola cantorum. This proper was originally appointed during Lent; in mode III, it shares characteristic formulae with other Lenten Offertory antiphons. The origin of the Offertory is elusive, but the first mention is a comment made by St. Augustine, at the end of the 4th century, about an African church.

Giovanni Paolo Cima (c. 1570 –1622), the composer of our Communion motet, was a leading musical figure in Milan in the early Baroque era. A contemporary of Claudio Monteverdi and Girolamo Frescobaldi, though not as well-known, Cima came from a family of musicians, and from 1595 he served as director of music and organist at the chapel of Santa Maria presso San Celso in Milan. His collection *Concerti ecclesiastici*, from which comes the piece we hear today, was published in 1610. He was the first composer to publish trio sonatas: the combination of two treble instruments and the basso continuo.

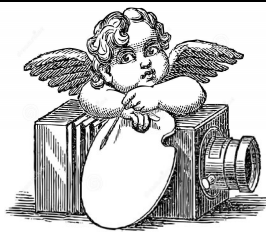
