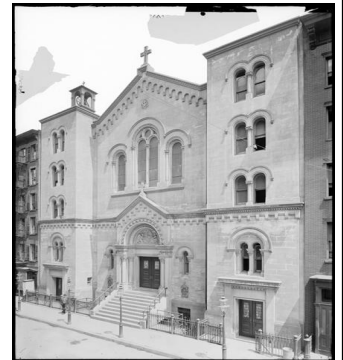

FEAST OF THE MOST PRECIOUS

BLOOD: Today, July 2nd, the Feast of the Most Precious Blood is being celebrated with a Sunday Mass at 5:00PM which is sponsored by the Sacred Military Constantinian Order of St. George. Traditionally, the first Sunday in July was set aside for this Feast until it was removed from the church calendar in 1969. The church felt that adoration attributed to the Precious Blood is satisfied by its inclusion in the Mass and the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (Corpus Christi). Devotees still honor and celebrate this day and, appropriately, it is being celebrated here at Most Precious Blood Church.



Devotion to the Precious Blood began with Mary as she collected Jesus' blood on the day of His circumcision. This was the first of seven Blood-sheddings of Jesus. The other six are: The Agony in the Garden; The Scourging at the Pillar; The Crowning with Thorns; The Way of the Cross; The Crucifixion and The Piercing of His Heart.

MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD CHOIR: We are currently in the process of forming a choir at MPB Church. This is something we haven't done in far too long and is way overdue. We are looking for 10 or so people; some of our loyal parishioners have already signed up. The first meeting will take place on Wednesday, July 19th at approximately 1:00PM after the 12:10PM Mass.
