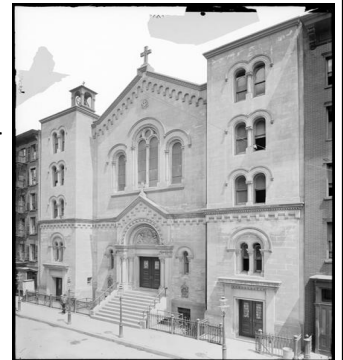

ANNUAL MASS IN HONOR OF SAINT ROCCO: The Saint Rocco Society of Potenza is honoring their beloved Saint today. Saint Rocco devoted himself to victims of the plague. During his travels where he cured countless plague victims he, himself, contracted the dread disease. He took refuge in a cave where he lay waiting for death. A dog wandered into the cave and discovered (not-quite-yet a saint) Rocco. Miraculously, he took bread to Rocco every day as a way to sustain him. One day the dog was followed into the cave by a curious nobleman. Upon seeing Rocco, he took pity on him and brought him to his castle where Rocco was cured. S.S. MARIA DI CORGISNANO: Next Saturday is the Annual Mass in Honor of SS. Maria di Corsignano. The society is no longer active in the traditional way; however, descendants of the original founders are still extremely dedicated to this Madonna, known as the patron saint of Giovinazzo. Members of the Elluzzi Family keep this annual Mass going as a tribute not only to the Madonna but to their family members who began this devotion in America – in Little Italy - so many years ago. A glitch in the website prevented us from sharing the history of the Madonna as she relates to Giovinazzo. The website is in Italian and, although we were able to have the information translated into English, we were not able to print it.
