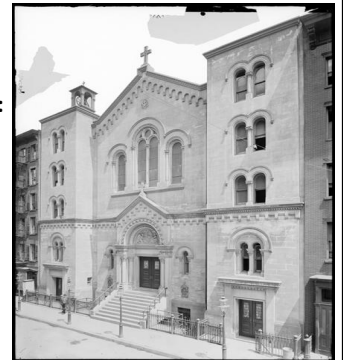

**SEPTEMBER 11th, 2001 ANNIVERSARY:**

This coming Tuesday is the 16th Anniversary of the terror attack on New York City's World Trade Center. Mass will be celebrated at St. Patrick's Old Cathedral at 10:30 AM for those members of Battalion 2 who gave their lives. Whether you attend Mass or not, no matter where you find yourself on that day, please take a moment to pray for all the innocent souls who perished in that tragedy. If you have not done so already and get the opportunity to do so, please visit the WTC Memorial Museum and Memorial Park. It is incredible how something so amazingly beautiful could be created on the site where such horror, destruction and devastation took place. **SAN GENNARO FEAST:** Thursday, September 14th, is the first day of the 91st Annual San Gennaro Feast which ends on Sunday, September 24th. The Solemn High Mass will be at 6:00PM on Tuesday, September 19th, the feast day of San Gennaro, followed by the religious procession where the statue of San Gennaro is carried through the streets of Little Italy. In between these traditional, religious rituals there will be numerous events. Within the church itself, there will be an old-fashioned puppet show featuring Italian Marionettes on September 20th and a concert featuring Italian Arias, Neapolitan Songs and Songs of Inspiration on September 22nd at 7:30PM. The feast will end with the annual blood drive with the Red Cross which takes place on Sunday, September 24th at the St. Patrick's Youth Center at 268 Mulberry Street.
