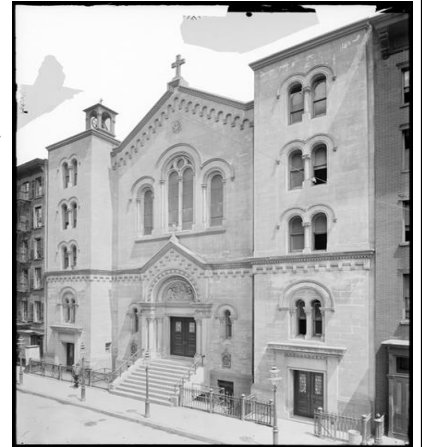
FREE SENIOR CITIZEN'S LEGAL ASSISTANCE will be provided to seniors in need of advice, guidance, etc. After the San
