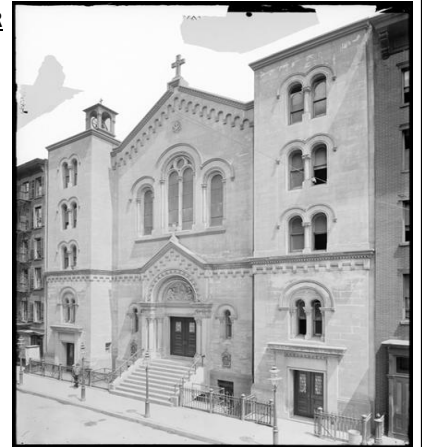
ITEMS OF INTEREST DURING THE SAN GENNARO FEAST:

There will be Mass daily during the San Gennaro Feast. The schedule is as follows: all weekdays and Sundays - 12:10PM; Saturdays – 5:30PM Vigil Mass. NOTE: As always, the solemn high Mass in honor of San Gennaro’s Feast Day takes place on September 19th at 6:00PM. The religious procession with the statue being carried through Little Italy begins immediately after Mass at approximately 7:00PM.

There will be an abbreviated performance of the musical “Mulberry Street” on Thursday, September 20th and Friday, September 21st inside Most Precious Blood Church. The play focuses on an immigrant family living in Little Italy in the 1950’s. It follows events of immigrant parents who became fruit peddlers and the conflicts between them and their son who had a more American idea of what his lifestyle should be. The play offers music, laughter (perhaps some tears) and promises to be thoroughly entertaining. The play begins at 7:30PM and tickets are \$10.00 at the door.

BLOOD DRIVE: Our annual blood drive in honor of the miracle of the liquefaction of San Gennaro’s 2000-year-old blood takes place, as always, on the last day of the San Gennaro feast – Sunday, September 23rd. The blood drive will be held in the youth center of the Basilica of St. Patrick’s Old Cathedral, 268 Mulberry Street, from 11:30AM to 6:00PM. Refreshments are offered to all who donate blood. Included in the refreshments are cannolis donated by John ‘Baby John’ DeLutro of Caffe Palermo, and pizza donated by Pasquale of Cha-Cha’s/Alleve Dairy. Other snacks and juices are offered as well.
