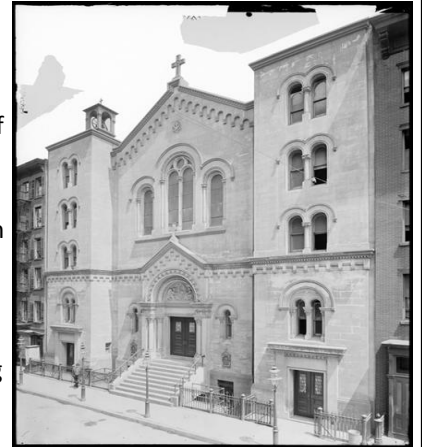

**BULLETIN NEWS –
DECEMBER 1-2, 2018**

ADVENT SEASON BEGINS:

Today marks the beginning of the Advent Season where Catholics begin a formal ‘waiting period’ for the birth of Jesus Christ, our Savior. The Advent Candle symbolizes the contrast between darkness and light, sin being the darkness and Christ being the “Light of the



World”; His birth on Christmas Day is a sign that God will fulfill His promise to redeem the human race, making all things new by sending his son, Jesus, to save us. The four weeks leading up to the birth of Jesus are marked by four candles in the Advent Wreath. Traditionally, their meaning is as follows:

1st Sunday of Advent: symbolizes hope with the ‘Prophet’s Candle’ reminding us that Jesus is coming. 2nd Sunday of Advent: symbolizes faith with the ‘Bethlehem Candle’ reminding us of Joseph and Mary’s journey to Bethlehem. 3rd Sunday of Advent: symbolizes joy with the ‘Shepherd’s Candle’ reminding us of the joy the world experienced at the coming birth of Jesus and, lastly, the 4th Sunday of Advent: symbolizes peace with the ‘Angel’s Candle’ reminding us of the message of the angels – “Peace on Earth, Good Will Toward Men”.

PEARL HARBOR DAY is on December 7th, marking the day America was attacked by the Imperial Japanese Navy Air Service. The attack took place on December 7, 1941 at the Pearl Harbor naval base located in Hawaii. This attack led to the United States’ entry into World War II. As we always encourage our parishioners to do, please remember our military personnel in your prayers and, if you should have the honor of meeting one of our troops on the street, please remember to thank them for their service. We are ‘the land of the free’ because of the brave.
