 - a. Vision 2016: Becky reported that the Tri Parish plan has been submitted, but we have not heard anything yet. It was noted that Fr Kurt and Becky had heard that transitions to oratory were going to be staggered so they do not happen all at once. But we have no reason for why the Diocese would do it that way.

4. New Business:
 - a. Faith Formation Report: Nichole Paladie reported that Lenten FF Activities are going well with Shadow Stations of the cross happening last week at HR and this week at SC. All FF Classes will have taught "Circle of Grace" Curriculum by the end of this week. Learning centers for the 2nd grade have been completed. With the loss of Chris Mulvihill last week, the 9th Grade class at HR will need new teachers to finish the year. People have been approached and we are just waiting for responses. Confirmation letters and reports are completed, with the letters being sent to the Bishop this week. Youth Ministry has been busy also, with a small group going to Intermission last week and Radiant Adoration happening monthly. Have had many adults enjoying the Radiant adoration, signifying and interest in Charismatic worship. There has been an interest in having a father/son group at the churches and a few families has met, but no activities have been planned yet, still in the organizing stage.
 - b. Social Justice Committee: Nichole Paladie reported that the group has had two meetings so far and there are a few things they would like to do to help raise awareness of Soc. Justice in our churches. The group has 3 things they wanted the Council to consider. 1) Having a fundraiser with Note cards made by the group 2) Having a visual mural of pictures at each church made from pictures taken by mission groups and put onto canvas. (Group would find sponsors for pictures so the parishes would not be paying for them). 3) Having a fundraiser on April 22 in conjunction with the Seder Supper at HR. After discussion a motion was made by Kathy Schumann to approve the wall pictures at each church, with final approval or supervision of the murals by Fr Kurt and Becky and to approve the fundraiser in April.
