The Athletic Director and Committee will review all potential candidates and conduct interviews the following week. It is the goal to have the new Coordinator in place by the start of the 2018-2019 season.

The primary responsibilities of the coordinator include being a resource and advisor for OLV Basketball (coaches and team managers), interpreting CYO rules, being the first point of contact for managing minor player or parent concerns, and acting as liaison to the Athletic Director.
