DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA NOVEMBER 9, 2014

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

In the midst of a fair amount of turmoil over the past week, due to the announcements of parish mergers and churches which will no longer be used much for public worship, I re-discovered that this Sunday the Church celebrates the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica on November 9, 324 A.D. original Church there in Rome was dedicated 1690 years ago, although the present Church dates only to the year 1646 (a mere 368 years ago). The Lateran property in Rome has undergone many changes over the centuries. Originally, it was given to Pope Sylvester I and became the residence of the popes from around 324 until 1309. When the popes returned from exile in Avignon, they began to live elsewhere in Rome. The Basilica, first commissioned by Emperor Constantine, remained the Cathedral of the Pope as the Bishop of Rome despite extensive renovations. It remains as such to this day. (I last visited the Lateran Basilica a couple of days before Pope Francis took possession of it in April 2013.)

I write all of this not because I plan on giving a quiz, but because it dawned on me this week that even in the city of Rome, a city now with 800 churches of different sizes and shapes, things change when it comes to church buildings, and structures and even parish boundaries. St. Peter's Basilica, which we often associate as the Pope's church and Residence, came along 1200 years after the original church at the Lateran was built.

The most important thing is that whether there was one church or 800 in Rome, Mass has been celebrated there for 20 centuries. The most important "temples" are the people of the Church, the "living stones" of God's dwelling place. Here in the Archdiocese, many people are upset because churches are merging or parish life is disrupted, but I think we all have to thank God for our faith and our Church, the Catholic Church established by Jesus which grows and adapts to the times, but never fades away. Jesus promised St. Peter that even the gates of hell would not prevail against the Church. We have to do our part to help one another believe in His enduring presence.
