Dear Parishioners,

As I write these words, Dr. Douglas Adams, the Superintendent of the Ramapo Central School District, is on his canonical retreat before ordination. Doug Adams is finishing his preparation to be ordained a deacon next month. Canon Law requires those to be ordained to write a letter to petition the bishop (in this case Cardinal Dolan) and to complete a five day spiritual retreat. If married, the deacon candidate's wife must also indicate her consent to the ordination. Lisa Adams has already done so. As you can imagine, this is a busy time of year for a superintendent of schools but Doug is committed to completing his formation according to the Church's schedule. Thankfully, he is called to serve in this parish.

Please keep Doug Adams and his classmates in your prayers as their June 25th ordination date approaches. In fact, if anyone would like to try to attend the Ordination on June 25 at Saint Patrick's Cathedral at 9am, I would say there is a good chance that there will be some seating space in the newly renovated Cathedral. (The candidates to be ordained deacons were not given many tickets for guests.)

By the way, please keep the men preparing for Ordination to the Priesthood in your prayers also. Priesthood Ordination will likewise be at St. Patrick's Cathedral but that date is Saturday May 28, 2016 at 9am.

The Lord continues to call men to the Priesthood and Diaconate in our day. Perhaps it is even tougher to respond positively to a religious vocation in these days because our "culture" does not hold religion in high esteem. Thank the Lord that many people still see religion as the important part of life it is, and men and women continue to follow the call and either be ordained or enter religious life.

May soon-to-be Deacon Adams and family find joy and peace in his vocation as a Deacon and may the Lord help him to serve the people of the Church in Jesus' name.

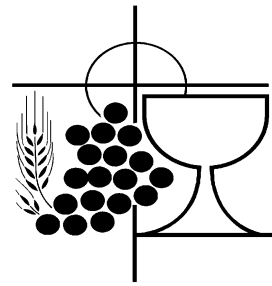
