And we pray for the heroic firefighters, police officers, and emergency workers who died trying to save others at the World Trade Center, and those who have died in the years after up to today from lung disease contracted by exposure to the toxic air at Ground Zero. for the passengers on the plane that was flown into the Pentagon and for all those killed working there that day, and for the heroic passengers who rose up against the terrorists on the plane that crashed into a

field in Pennsylvania on its way to do more destruction in our Nation's Capital.

We pray, too, for our military men and women serving throughout the world who sacrifice so much for our safety and freedom, for those who have died far away in war in the aftermath of 9/11 up to today, and for all those who continue to mourn the death of their loved ones. And in a special way we pray for our Country, for our Leaders, and most especially for peace in our world, in our homes, and in our hearts. "Jesus, I Trust in You." May God bless us all.
