A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Today we join the Church throughout the world in observing World Mission Sunday. *Mission* is at the very heart of the Church's identity - that is to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to every person on earth. Our faith is not a private matter, but is at the very core of who we are. However, we live in a society that tells us to keep our faith to ourselves. God is being expelled from every aspect of public life, and we are paying a heavy price for it. As Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI often said, *"when God is pushed out of public life, the void that is created will be filled by the evil one."* I don't think that is too hard to see.

World Mission Sunday is giving us a much different message. We have a grave duty as believers in Jesus Christ to be a light to the world, to be the leaven in our society, to permeate our culture with the values of Jesus Christ. Our faith is not to be conformed to the ways of the world, but rather to conform the world to the ways of God. And that takes a lot of conviction and a lot of courage today.

From the moment of our Lord's Command to His Apostles over 2000 years ago to "go and teach all nations," heroic men and women right up to today have left their homelands to be missionaries in faraway lands. Certainly not all are called to leave home and go far away to spread the Gospel. However, by our baptism we are all called to be missionaries where we live and work. In fact, the real challenge today is not so much reaching those in distant lands who never heard of Christ, but reaching those right here at home who need to be re-introduced to Him and our beautiful Catholic faith - so many who, for various reasons, have stopped practicing their faith, stopped coming to Sunday Mass, or just stopped believing. It is a constant pang of conscience for me that we are not doing enough to reach out and invite people back, and to nourish our people more in the faith.

Our world is in desperate need of God. That is what Our Lady was telling us through Her message to the children at Fatima 100 years ago when she said that prayer and penance is the only

way to Peace in our world. These are similar words that our Lord, Himself, spoke to St. Faustina, that "the world will never find peace until it turns to my Mercy." We are in great need today of reevangelizing our culture, of re-introducing Jesus and the timeless Truth of His Gospel to the modern age. May we pray and support the missionary work of the Church throughout the world, and recommit ourselves to being missionaries here at home by living our faith with all our might. May God bless us all.
