A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

What a great week we have coming up with the culmination of our 150th Anniversary Year. Archbishop Charles Balvo, the Papal Nuncio to Kenya, who grew up in our Parish and went to our School, will be coming all the way from Africa to be the Main Celebrant for our Anniversary Mass this Friday evening on our Feast Day, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. We also welcome Father Javier home this weekend, who came a month earlier than usual to celebrate with us both at the Mass Friday evening and at the Gala Dinner Dance on Saturday evening. Please come and make this a beautiful celebration of our Parish and an expression of our love for it.

What a fitting way we have to start off this special week with today's Feast of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is a day for special Eucharistic celebration and devotion, like our Eucharistic Procession after the 1:00pm Mass Sunday afternoon as we walk around our property holding up the Blessed Sacrament in the Monstrance for all to see as we proclaim our Faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church puts it: *"The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life...For in the Blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ Himself."*

As a kid preparing for First Communion I was taught to say *"My Lord and My God"* when the Large Host and the Chalice are lifted up at the Consecration. I still say those words at the Consecration every time I offer Mass. How beautifully and powerfully we express our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus and draw others to this mystery by the reverence we show toward the Eucharist – in our fidelity to Sunday Mass; in the way we genuflect before the Tabernacle; in the way we bow with reverence as we approach to receive Holy Communion; in the way we take time to pray and give thanks as we savor the Real Presence of Jesus in our bodies and souls after receiving Him in Holy Communion. These kinds of outward gestures of reverence, including our Eucharistic Procession on Sunday afternoon, speak volumes about the faith we hold deep in our hearts.

May this beautiful Feast of Corpus Christi and our Parish's 150th Anniversary celebration help lead us to give thanks and praise to Almighty God for this priceless treasure we have right in our midst every day in our own beautiful Church, The Real Presence of our Lord Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament. May God bless us all.

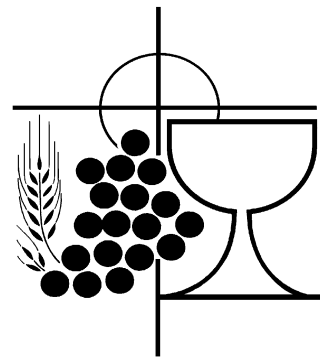
