We thank Archbishop Charles Balvo for coming home all the way from Africa to celebrate the Mass with us. It was such an honor to welcome him home for this great moment in our Parish's history where he grew up and graduated from our School. The Mass was so beautiful and inspiring. It was so good to have some of the priests who have served here over the years concelebrate the Mass, including our beloved former Pastor, Msgr. Giandurco.

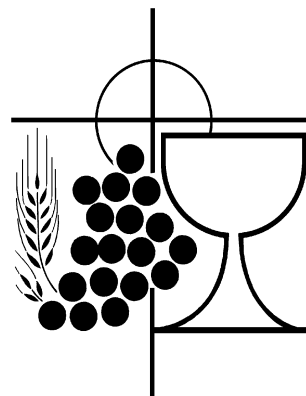
