#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

It is hard to believe that this is Fr. Innocent's last Sunday with us. I cannot thank him enough for being such a blessing to our parish, for being the wonderful priest that is, and for being such a good friend to me. He will be greatly missed. Next week we will welcome another wonderful priest, Fr. Charles Achi, who is being sent to us by Cardinal Dolan from Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish in Staten Island. Fr. Charles is originally from Nigeria, and like Fr. Innocent, is in the process of being incorporated into the Archdiocese of New York. Let us welcome him with all our hearts.

In these times we are living in we need to get back to the basics of prayer and penance. This is what our Blessed Mother implored us to do over 100 years ago in her message to us through the children at Fatima, as she implored us to pray the Rosary every day for Peace. Our Lady also asked that we keep the special devotion of Five First Saturdays. That is, for five consecutive First Saturdays we go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, pray the Rosary, and spend 15 minutes with Our Lady meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary. This devotion has a special place in our Lady's plan for bringing about peace in our world through prayer and penance (See the flier in today's bulletin).

Accordingly, we will observe the First Saturday Devotion requested by Our Lady of Fatima here at Sacred Heart beginning the First Saturday of October next week. Every First Saturday from now on, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the main altar during the usual time for Confession from 4:00 to 5:00pm, and the Rosary and prayers will be led by our Tuesday night prayer group dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Hopefully, many of us will take this opportunity to observe the Five First Saturdays Devotion as Our Lady requested for the sake of peace in our world, in our church, in our families, and in our hearts. Our Lady promised that in the end her Immaculate Heart will triumph over all the evil in our world. Let us work toward this by bringing about this triumph in our own hearts by consecrating them to the Immaculate Heart of Mary now.

Finally, to go from the spiritual to the temporal, we need to make one last push to wrap up the Renew and Rebuild Capital Campaign. I have not pushed it during the month of September since it just didn't

seem the right time, but we must continue for the good our own beautiful Parish of Sacred Heart. We will conduct one more "Commitment Weekend" when everyone will have another opportunity to make a pledge during Mass on the weekend of October 13-14 and finish up the Campaign by November. Please read my letter in the flier in today's bulletin. We have done exceptionally well so far with almost 1.6 million dollars in pledges toward our goal of 2.1 million dollars. If everyone does whatever they can, we will raise that remaining \$600,000 and accomplish some wonderful things for our beautiful Church. And thank you to all of you who have already so generously made your pledge. May God bless us all.
