Dear Parishioners,

We have announced and run some info about the Mass and party we will have on Friday the 23rd of this Month. I wish it was not the night of graduation, but this is the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart on the Church’s calendar. We are having the dedication of the Church Hall on this date because after much consultation I felt it was important to have a permanent reminder to Most Sacred Heart Parish and Church, especially since this last year we sold the property to the Goodwill Church. We are redoing the flooring down the stairwell and it will be much safer for all to go down and use the Hall. The new name of the Hall will be Most Sacred Heart Hall and Deacon and I have worked to have a painting cleaned that was is the hall at Most Sacred Heart and to have a stained glass window from the church redone and placed in the wall of the Hall. I think it will be a very nice addition to our Hall. This has been a sizable project and let me be honest, the parish did not receive personally any money from the sale of Most Sacred Heart. The proceeds were used to pay old bills that had piled up (new boiler, roof work, taxes and general upkeep). Steve Riordan has agreed to organize and cook a nice meal to celebrate this day and it will be a pleasure to have Father Dan O’Hare back with us to bless the Most Sacred Heart Hall. If anyone would like to donate to this evening we will take up a free will collection at Mass, don’t feel any obligation, but if you would like to assist, it would be greatly appreciated to cover the dinner, and all the work that has been completed.

Just a little reminder of the significance of the devotion to the Most Sacred Heart, which was pushed especially by Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque. He promised that, in response to those who consecrate themselves and make reparations to His Sacred Heart, that:

- He will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
- He will establish peace in their homes.
- He will comfort them in all their afflictions.
- He will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death.
- He will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
- Sinners will find in His Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
- Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
- He will bless every place in which an image of His Heart is exposed and honored.
- He will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in His Heart.
- In the excessive mercy of His Heart that His all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy

Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in His disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. His divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.
