Dear Father,

As we begin this holiest week of the year, you are in our prayers as you enter with Jesus into His Passion, Death, and Resurrection. We are grateful for your outpouring of self, a living example of your fatherly love for all lives entrusted to your care.

We know many have spent this Lent troubled by the condition of our State. The devastation of the Reproductive Health Act cannot be adequately measured. This law has awoken many. Now, New York is facing Physician-Assisted Suicide. On April 9<sup>th</sup>, the Governor, for the first time, publicly expressed in a radio interview his wish to sign into law Physician-Assisted Suicide. We desire to work in partnership with you to ensure that this does not happen.

We need your help. Our office has planned a week of events called Life Week to run from Divine Mercy Sunday, April 28 through May 4, 2019, which brings to life parishioner-generated ideas culminating in the already-scheduled *Focus on the Family* Event "Alive from New York" on May 4<sup>th</sup>. We are asking you to help promote these events through your parish bulletin, Mass announcements, and bulletin boards.

We have sent you a bulletin insert with the activities for Life Week. The week has three components:

1. Call Campaign – Parishioners are encouraged to call their legislators throughout the week using a script provided that expresses our opposition to Physician Assisted Suicide.
2. Mass for the Unborn – On May 4<sup>th</sup>, we invite you to celebrate your already-scheduled Saturday morning Mass as *the Mass for Giving Thanks to God for the Gift of Human Life* in the Roman Missal. You will be united with those praying the Noon Mass at the Cathedral (celebrated for the Unborn).
3. The "Alive from New York" event on Saturday, May 4, from 2:30-4:30pm. The event is expected to draw thousands to Times Square to celebrate the sanctity of human life, with live music and guest speakers. Jeanne Mancini of the National March for Life in Washington D.C. will host the afternoon, and His Eminence Cardinal Dolan will give a video message on the jumbo screens.

These events provide an avenue for the lay faithful to show their support for human life through prayer, witness, and involvement in public policy. We hope that it will unite parishioners in the cause of life across the Archdiocese. Thank you for your participation.
