

You must have a 94/A or higher in a class for each of the first three quarters and also for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter going into exams, with no work missing in any of the four quarters, to be eligible for exemption from the final exam in that class. However, if you would like to take the exam to boost your grade to a higher A for class rank purposes, it is permissible. You will, however, earn whatever you score on the exam. It is possible to lower your grade with a poor score on the exam. Exemption is a privilege, and may be revoked at the discretion of the teacher if effort is not consistent.
