# Wish List Update

It has been a very busy few weeks with lots of things happening and items being crossed off the wish list.

**#1 Priority** has been debt reduction and the congregation has responded with incredible generosity. Although the initial goal of \$133,000 seemed somewhat unreachable, we are currently past \$40,000 in donations along with moving forward on meeting our goal for Living and Giving in Christ, the Diocesan Appeal at the same time.

A new credence table has been moved into the sanctuary and the old table is used to hold missalettes in the southwest corner of the nave ( seating area).

During all of the high winds on Wednesday, the unlocked front door did not open accidentally throughout the day. This is a major improvement and a great fix!

Thanks to an incredible effort by a number of people, all of the boxes of books and educational materials were concentrated in the classrooms and then sorted. This should allow us to start our youth religious education program on the 1st Sunday in October. We have the makings of an extensive library and were able to find items that had been misplaced for more years than we care to admit. As bookshelves and bookcases are obtained, the books will be categorized and made accessible to everybody.

The bathrooms in the classroom area are progressing smoothly as the dividers are installed. The bathrooms are currently functional.

The classroom access, front walkways, and landscaping have been prepared for the concrete placement which should occur in the next few weeks.

We are preparing to enter our database into our ParishSoft software in the next month. We will be asking for members who are not registered to do so in order to get our records complete and most importantly, current.

A busy summer, with a lot happening and a lot of progress being made by people making things happen. Thank you!!!!!!
