### EASTER FLOWERS

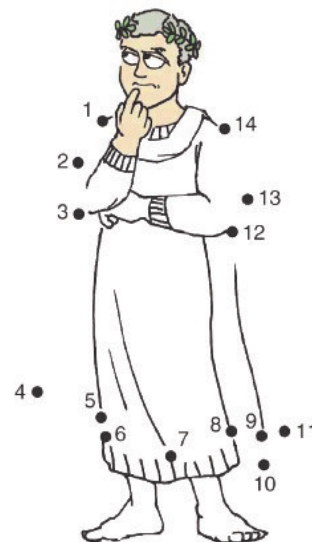
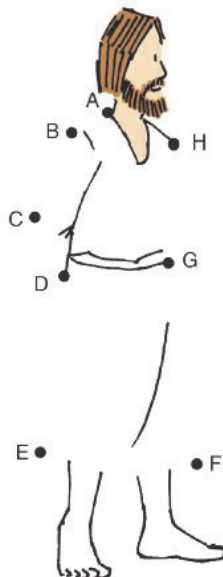
