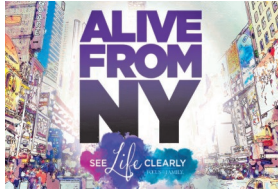
HOMEBOUND: For those confined at home, Extraordinary Ministers bring Holy Communion. If anyone is not on the regular list, please call the Rectory.

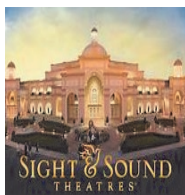
Tickets are \$1 each or a book of 12 for \$10. The Grand Prize is \$2,500. Please support them in their effort to help those who need it most. Thank you!.

Mother's Day is Sunday, May 12th. Masses at St. Margaret's will be offered for all our mothers, living and dead. For those who would like them, **Mother's**

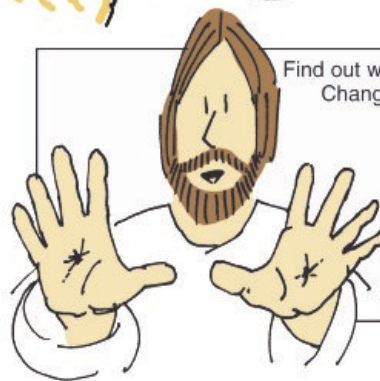
Day Spiritual Bouquet Cards are available in the vestibule of St. Margaret's Church.
