**Propagation of the Faith Appeal
August 11th and 12th**

**Congregation of St. Maria Goretti
Diocese of Shinyanga**

This weekend the 11th and 12th, Sr. Candida Massabo from Tanzania is coming to our parish to do a mission appeal for the needs of her religious Order: St. Maria Goretti Congregation based in northwestern Tanzania. She comes to us as a the guest of the Mission Office of the Archdiocese to share with us her missionary works and appeal for our support.

The Congregation of St. Maria Goretti was founded in 2010, in the Diocese of Shinyanga, Tanzania - East Africa. The Congregation is growing fast. It now has 80 members and has extended missionary works in three dioceses.

As a new religious congregation, it has many needs, such as: building of a Chapel, a formation house for new candidates, class rooms, Convent for Sisters and other needs. At this time, the most urgent need of the congregation is to help young women and men who are victims of domestic violence and sexual abuses and poverty.

In 2014, the Congregation started an Elementary school to help all these young girls and boys to acquire education. Our Congregation could only build four classes from grade one to grade four, building one class every year. We need financial help to build three more classrooms.

The estimated cost for each classroom is about \$15,000 and with the three classes, the need \$45,000. The goal of the Congregation is to educate these children to the high school level so that they can be able to decide about their future life.

The Congregation of St. Maria Goretti will remember you in prayer for your support and request your prayers.
