

The Archdiocese of New York's Golden Jubilee Wedding Mass will take place on Sunday, June 2, 2019 at 2:00 PM at Saint Patrick's Cathedral. The Mass is for couples celebrating 50 years of marriage in 2019. His Eminence, Cardinal Dolan will be officiating.



All who wish to attend this Mass must register with their parish and have a ticket for admission. Registration will close on Monday, May 13 at 5:00 PM.

Pews will be reserved for jubilarians only. Additional family and friends will be accommodated in pews outside of the reserved section in four general seating areas.

In addition to the Mass, all golden jubilee couples will receive a certificate acknowledging their marriage. Couples who are unable to attend the Mass but are celebrating 50 years of marriage can also register with their parish to receive a certificate.
