PILGRIM PAMPHLET GUIDE

A recommended practice for Lent is to make a pilgrimage. A Pilgrim Pamphlet Guide is available to parishioners today the Fifth Sunday of Lent and on Palm Sunday for anyone who wishes to participate in the venerable custom of visiting seven churches" on Maundy (Holy) Thursday evening, April 18, 2019, for prayer, reflection and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The evening Mass time at each church in Dutchess and Ulster counties, the location of the Altar of Repose (repository) and the closing time of adoration are in the pamphlet. Pope Francis' prayer intentions for April 2019 are included as well as suggested scriptural prayer verses for seven churches. Pilgrims normally set out after attending the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper at their home parish; at this Mass a plenary indulgence may be gained during the solemn procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose. They then go on a self-directed "visit" to six other churches. St. Philip Neri in the 16th century Rome gave us the tradition of visiting seven churches. (A Spanish version is available of the pamphlet)
