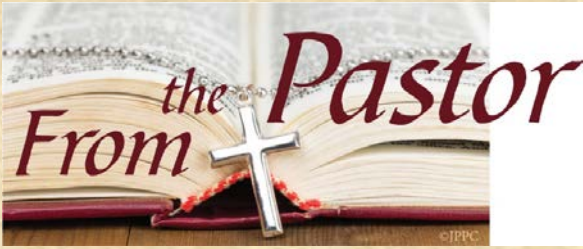
2020 MASS BOOK
