Join us June 22-26 at St. Augustine for a multi-parish Vacation Bible School. We will gather each day from 9am-12noon at Base Camp (St. Augustine Parish Center) to explore Mount Everest and learn about how God helps us to conquer challenges in our lives. We need lots of Adults and Youth to help us lead our PK4 through 5th grade young people during this week. We have many options for you to help with, so talk to Jeanette Benson or Janet Maucione and let us know how you may be able to serve. Our first volunteer training will be at St. Augustine, Thur., May 27th at 6:30 PM. We need help decorating in the mornings from June 15-18 and will have another meeting during that time period. As you are praying for the people of Nepal, directly affected by last week's earthquakes, and the mountain climbers that were on Mount Everest at the time, know that we will be having a special intention during our VBS week to collect money to send to Catholic Relief Services for this area.

We welcome Bishop Daly to Spokane:

The liturgies of welcoming Bishop Daly to the Diocese of Spokane and his Installation as the seventh Bishop of Spokane are scheduled for Tuesday and Wednesday, May 19 and 20 at Our Lady of Lourdes Cathedral. Due to limited seating, representatives from each parish will attend the evening prayer and the Installation Mass. **On Wednesday, May 20, 2:00 p.m. the Installation Mass will be live-streamed on the web site of KHQ-TV, khq.com. EWTN-will schedule broadcasts of the Mass at a later date. In addition to livestreaming by khq.com, the installation Mass will be carried live by Sacred Heart Radio, KTTO – 970 AM. There will be a public reception for Bishop Daly at the Cathedral of Our Lady of Lourdes, 1115 W. Riverside Ave. on Wednesday, May 20, from 3:30-5:30 p.m. All are welcome; no ticket is required for the reception.**

For 20 years, students from colleges and universities across America have crossed America on foot, bearing witness to the Culture of Life. Walkers on the northern route depart from Seattle on May 23. They will visit Sacred Heart and other parishes in Spokane to ask for our help and prayers, and to carry our prayer intentions with them as they proclaim the Gospel of Life across America.

Pastoral Council
