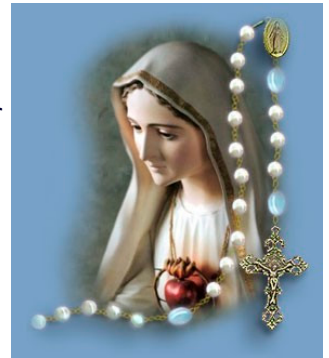
Blue envelopes are found in the pack of offering envelopes many of you receive by mail or in the pews.

# Eucharistic Family Rosary Crusade

**You are invited to gather with thousands of your fellow Catholics in the Diocese of Spokane for the upcoming Eucharistic Family Rosary Crusade this coming July!**

**The Crusade will take place on July 23rd, beginning at 7:00 pm at Avista Stadium in Spokane.**

With Bishop Thomas Daly and Crusade founder Fr. James Kelleher, we will come together to honor Our Lady of Fatima on this 100-year Anniversary of the Fatima Apparitions, and to pray for peace in the world, in the family, and for our youth.



The Eucharistic Family Rosary Crusade was founded in Rome by Father James Kelleher on the day of the beatification of St. Teresa of Calcutta, Oct. 19, 2003. The Eucharistic Family Rosary Crusade takes as its spiritual patrons Pope St. John Paul II and St. Teresa of Calcutta. Both of these saints had a great devotion to both the rosary and Eucharistic adoration. Father James Kelleher is a priest of the Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity or SOLT. His order is involved in missionary work both in the United States and abroad.

The evening will begin with a 60-person choir leading us in praise and worship. There will be an entrance procession of several hundred people led by Bishop Daly, including 100 First Communicants in their white garments. After the exposed Eucharist is placed on the altar for all to adore, 59 bilingual beads will form a Global Living Rosary with each decade representing a different continent. Each "living bead" will pray the first part of the Hail Mary in a foreign language and the congregation will respond in English.

Admissions is Free! Distribution of Miraculous Medals, rosaries and bottled water are also free. Gates will open at 5:30 pm and seats are first come first serve!

The Crusade is now working on arranging free busing to and from Avista. So, stay tuned to find out where buses will be accessed. We will keep you posted.
