Our Sacred Heart Parish Adult Spiritual Formation Groups meet each week! Please feel free to join us.



A Word from Father...



Dear Friends,

As you by now know, our parish family is celebrating this year the 50th Anniversary of the dedication of our lovely church building. It is so much more than just a building, as we all experience every week! This is where for fifty years we have baptized our children and grand-children, grieved over our loved ones who have passed on to Eternal Life, been touched by the proclamation of God’s Word, broken the Bread and shared the Cup, offered to friend and stranger alike Christ’s peace, praised God’s goodness in song, and come for quiet prayer alone in good times and hard times. It is more than just “a church”...it is our parish family’s *home!*

The parish’s Pastoral Council and I have been discussing for the past year how best to celebrate the 50th anniversary of our church’s dedication and the ensuing years of prayer and praise that it has been home to; the results of those discussions have been two-fold:

- ◆ **First**, we will mark the anniversary of the church’s dedication by Bishop Topel with a special Sunday Mass on December 1st. That will be followed by a festive brunch at the Manito Golf & Country Club, (details to follow).
- ◆ **Second**, we decided to take this opportunity to initiate some important “upgrades” to the building itself.

The **first** will be an expansion and renovation of the lavatories in the vestibule so that they can accommodate those using walkers or wheel chairs and be compliant with ADA directives. The new bathrooms will expand into what used to be the “bride-room” and in more recent years has been used by the parish music ministry for storage.

The **second** will be a major modernization of our heating system, providing to the church air conditioning for the summer months and warmth during the winter. The new system will also be much more efficient in its use of energy, moving from the present 50% estimated efficiency to at least 80% and maybe a bit more.

As you can guess, these upgrades will not be inexpensive, so we are counting on all of us to help this possible. Through our **50th Anniversary Fund**, we hope to raise at least \$300,000 to fund these projects. Any additional funds that we raise will be used for other important projects here such as converting some of our lighting to LED or installing a ramped entry into the Social Hall. The parishioners of Sacred Heart have proven to be some of the most generous of any parish in our diocese and we count on that generosity once again as we celebrate the fiftieth anniversary of our church’s construction and dedication in 1969.
