From the Pastor's Desk...

My Dear Brother and Sisters,

Recently one of my priest friends from the Bronx was going on and on about how big a congregation he had on Easter Sunday. Finally he ended his conversation with the following wish, "Pancrose, I wish I had one third of this congregation for regular Sunday Masses. I couldn't agree more. I realized the gravity of his wish only after this past Sunday.

On Easter Sunday we had full church for all the Masses. One visibly upset regular parishioner told me on Easter Sunday that she had to stand through the whole Mass because of those who attend Church only on Christmas and Easter. I was able to calm her down by saying that many of them come so rarely to Church that even Jesus would stand and give up his seat for them as a sign of welcome. But this past Sunday the Church was half empty for most Masses. That made me to reflect on the question why one comes to Church. Some possible answers are: to show off, to fulfil an obligation, to see our friends and socialize, to pray and get some favor from God, to change our lives and become more like Christ. Johan van Parys in his book, What's the Smoke For? And Other Burning Questions about the liturgy writes the following,

The Ultimate test of our liturgical life: How does it change us?

The ultimate test of a Christian community's liturgical life is whether it changes lives. Does our liturgy call us to be one with the poor, to share our table with the hungry, to visit the sick, to embrace the dying? If so then we are well on our way to being more like Christ and our liturgy, no matter its style, is truly a foretaste and a rehearsal of the eternal Jerusalem.

In the end, if the liturgy does not change us into becoming more like Christ, then it is nothing but ritual fits and follies. So, let's celebrate the liturgy well so it may change our hearts and minds and send us into the world to make a difference.

Come to Church as a family because you belong to the Body of Christ. Pray for all God's favors but more than anything pray to change your lives and become more like Christ.
