TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Isaiah 53:10-11

Isaiah speaks of how the Servant of God will have to give his life up for the sins of other people. Because of this suffering the Servant will receive eternal life for himself and all the people whose sins are forgiven because of him.

Second Reading: Hebrews 4:14-16

Jesus is considered to be the new high priest and mediator between God and his people. Fortunately, Jesus has experienced the same temptations as other people, and so he has more tolerance of our weaknesses.

Gospel: Mark 10:35-45

Two of the disciples ask Jesus that they be allowed to sit at his right and left side when he comes into his glory. Jesus explains that they should not be concerned with their position. Instead they should concern themselves with serving others just as Jesus was planning to serve many in giving his own life for their sins.

From the Pastor's Desk...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Love from Nigeria. Today is the 8th of October. I am in Fr. Charles' home and just finished a grand lunch with the family. I shared your love, concern and prayers for them. This evening I will offer Mass in their house with two other priests from here. You will not believe how much love I enjoy from everyone here.

I wrote to you last time that I was leaving for vacation on the 1st of October. I arrived in London the next day. I was truly disappointed that the Queen of England did not come to receive me. But I went to see her in Buckingham Palace. After three days in London visiting all the important sights I found her with her entire family in the Wax Museum. You don't believe me...? I have a picture to prove it.

On October 6th I arrived in Abuja, Nigeria. Two priests picked me at the airport at 6 am. We started for the Bishop's House where Most Rev. Joseph Bagobiri (Fr. Charles' Bishop) is stationed. What a green landscape!!! Forests, Mountains, Palm trees, Mango groves and corn fields - absolutely gorgeous. We were driving on a six lane highway with excellent roads. Do you know that they have no speed limits here? The car driver decides what his speed limit needs to be, just like the autobahn in Germany. For an hour we were stuck in the traffic. All the cars looked like sardines in the sea trying to swim upward. At 12:30 we reached the Bishop's House where I got a Queen of England's Welcome.

Days pass so quickly. For the love and the warmth of everyone here, I long to stay here forever. But I have my next flight booked for Oct. 12th to New Delhi to visit my brother Most. Rev. Francis Kalist. From there I will go home and be back home with you on October 30th. Till then keep an eye on my two brother priests. United always in love and prayers.
