From the Pastor's desk ...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters

As a parish family there is nothing more joyful than celebrating the sacraments, especially the Sacraments of Christian Initiation. We call the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist as sacraments of initiation because they lay the foundations of every Christian life. Catechism of the Catholic Church states, "The sharing in the divine nature given to men through the grace of Christ bears a certain likeness to the origin, development, and nourishing of natural life. The faithful are born anew by Baptism, strengthened by the sacrament of Confirmation, and receive in the Eucharist the food of eternal life. By means of these sacraments of Christian initiation, they thus receive in increasing measure the treasures of the divine life and advance toward the perfection of charity." This is the reason why the Church canon law demands that any catholic who wishes to act as a sponsor must have received the Sacraments of Initiation. This weekend we join our 63 first communion children and their families in their joy of receiving the Body of Christ for the first time. Congratulations!

Today we celebrate Mother's Day and I wish Happy Mother's Day to all the mothers in our parish! "We remember all mothers with gratitude and affection," Pope Francis said to the crowds gathered in Saint Peter's Square under the hot sun for the recitation of the Regina Caeli prayer on May 10. "For those whose mothers and grandmothers are still alive - cherish them today. Hug and kiss them. Honor them. Thank them. For those whose mothers have gone home to the Lord, remember them.
