Parish Council Meeting...

Our Parish Council met on Wednesday, May 16th, 2018 at 7pm. in Fr. Hopkins Hall. Eighteen people were present. Our Pastor, Father Pancrose began the meeting with a prayer. The Secretary presented the minutes of the last meeting in September 2017. Then Father reported on the status of the renovations to the convent building. Interior repairs have been progressing. The repairs have been put on hold until school closes in June. The repairs will start up as soon as school closes and will be completed by the end of the summer. Father also spoke of other repairs that will be done over the summer. The schoolyard/parking lot and some pipes in the school boiler room must be repaired. This work can only be done when the school year is completed in June.

Father gave a financial update. We have \$750,000 pledged to our Renew and Rebuild Campaign with approximately \$280,000 collected out of which 123,000 has been paid for 2017 Cardinal's Appeal. The 2018 Cardinal's Appeal has \$80,000 pledged with \$70,000 collected so far. He said that we are currently financially stable; however, we have been experiencing a disturbing trend of decreasing Mass attendance and decreasing weekly collections.

Father voiced the concern that we all must work together to revitalize the parish. If the attendance at Masses continues to decrease (which also means that parishioner involvement in all aspects of parish life is diminishing), we may be advised to reduce out weekend Masses.

Father expressed the desire to review our parish registration. We currently have about 2000 families registered; however only 300 to 350 families use envelopes weekly and the number of people attending Mass on a regular weekly basis has been less than 1000. This is a disturbing trend. He intends to reach out to families, speaking with them and visiting with them.

Parish organizations presented reports, discussed the possibility of developing a youth group and discussed the need for all of us to work towards revitalizing our parish and rebuilding and nourishing the faith life of our parish families. The meeting ended at 8:55pm. Father Charles closed the meeting with a prayer.
