Gospel: John 10:27-30

Jesus states that his sheep know his voice and follow him, and will receive eternal life. Jesus also says that no one can snatch his followers away, because God is greater than anyone who might try, and Jesus is one with God.

From the Pastor's Desk ...

The Fourth Sunday of Easter, known as Good Shepherd Sunday, is also the "World Day of Prayer for Vocations." The Scripture lessons for this day concern the role of the shepherds of God's flock in the Church. Each year on this Sunday, we reflect on the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd who devotedly and kindly takes care of his flock. The title "pastor" means shepherd. A shepherd leads, feeds, nurtures, comforts, corrects, and protects his flock—responsibilities that belong to every Church leader. Today we thank all of our mothers, pray for them and honor them by celebrating Mother's Day and by offering our mothers on the altar of God whether they are alive here or have gone to their eternal reward.

This Mother's Day, let us acknowledge the truth that we have two mothers: our earthly mother and our Heavenly Mother, the Mother of Jesus. The Catholic Church proclaims the great nobility of the Mother of Jesus, Mary most holy, and presents her as the supreme model for all mothers. Let us show our love and appreciation for both of our mothers and let us ask our Heavenly Mother to take care of our earthly mothers. This Month we have many baptisms, First Holy Communions, Confirmation, and Weddings. Our congratulations to all of them, the newlyweds, teachers, parents and family. 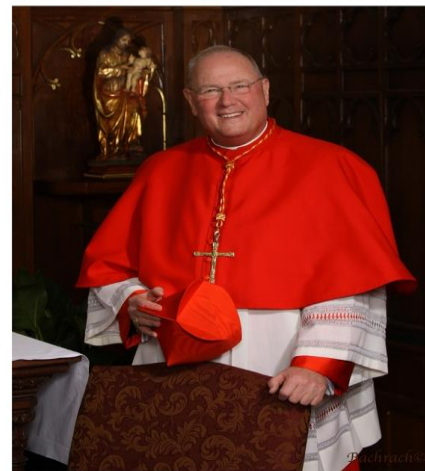

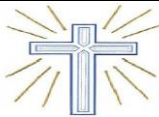
